The network, when complete, will be approximately 1,200 kilometres (750 mi) in length, will connect all seven of its emirates, and will link the UAE to the KSA via Ghuweifat in the west running to Fujairah on the east coast. The network will use diesel traction, with the potential to electrify in the future. Etihad Rail's freight trains will reach speeds up to 120 km/h (75 mph), and its passenger trains will reach speeds up to 200 km/h (120 mph).
